The children will listen to a range of stories and learn to write simple sentences correctly. This term we will be focusing on using full stops and capital letters correctly. They will describe the setting and different characters using adjectives and we will be encouraging them to use vocabulary that is more ambitious.			
Maths	The children will learn to read and write numbers correctly from 0 – 20 and then beyond and learn the skills needed to be able to count accurately. They will learn to place numbers correctly on a number line and compare numbers and put them in order. They will continue to develop their addition and subtraction skills with numbers to ten, then up to 20, and begin to understand doubling. The children will learn to name, describe and compare 2d shapes according to their properties.
