	In computing this term, we will be learning how to use a programme called Scratch. We will be looking at how to use loops and repetition to create shapes. Then, we will practise animating our own name

	Lastly, we will design our own game to play and create it.		
	As our indoor PE this term, we will be looking at badminton. We will focus on coordination, serving and

	prepare them for their new classes in September.
